

## Susan Guest-McPhail ~ Mixed Media Materials List

*You can drop in on this class and try it, materials included with first class!*

### To Paint On:

I suggest using gessoed 200 lb. paper which can be purchased from me at a low price  
You could also use small canvas panels, any watercolor paper etc.  
The idea is to do at least 2 per class.

### Paints:

Acrylic, buy a set of colors with white, red, yellow, blue, green or similar combination or use whatever acrylics you have.  
water container

### Brushes:

synthetic for acrylic a 1 inch flat is always a good bet but you could buy 1/2 inch and small for detail.  
Don't forget cheap brushes for glueing.  
Old credit cards, for painting, glueing etc.  
Matte or Gloss Medium for glueing, small bottle available at Arts Wholesale or internet, also, AC moore, Michaels

### Palette:

could be: paper plates, freezer paper, (I use), old white plates, waxed paper etc.

### Misc.

white trash bag to place under your work or a drop cloth.  
gesso  
scissors, any ruler, pencil, spray bottle, ( the best are travel hair spray bottles).  
2 bottles of acrylic inks, colors you like  
craft paints, ac moore etc. often 2/1.00  
bring in an old magazine for making paper to rip up  
foam meat trays are useful for printing  
printmaking roller  
colored papers, stamps, old map, etc.

I will have extras if you want to just try the techniques available
