#### **ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS:**

FIRST & THIRD SUMMER SHOWS –

One new artwork (painting, graphic, sculpture, or photograph) may be submitted per Juried Artist Member, not to exceed 40 inches image/canvas size on the longest side, plus a reasonably sized frame.

- SECOND & FOURTH SUMMER SHOWS (Juried for Entry)
  - **Up to two new artworks** (painting, graphic, sculpture, or photograph) may be submitted per Juried Artist Member, **not to exceed 40 inches image/canvas size on the longest side**, plus a reasonably sized frame.
- Artwork submitted must be signed, original, recent, and not previously shown at the RAA&M.
- All two-dimensional artwork must be suitably framed or gallery wrapped and ready to hang securely with wire and screw eyes.
- Completing the online registration form is required before delivering artwork. A printed copy of your registration form will be on hand to attach to the back of your artwork when it is dropped off.
- Artwork must be the property of the artists of the RAA&M. All artwork must be for sale.
- The Arts & Exhibitions Committee reserves the right to reject work that is not properly presented.
- Artwork will NOT be hung unless membership dues are paid. Please visit our Wild Apricot member portal to pay your Juried Artist Membership dues: <a href="https://raaam.wildapricot.org/">https://raaam.wildapricot.org/</a>
- The RAA&M will not be responsible for receiving or returning shipments of artwork unless prior special arrangements have been made.
- ARTWORK SALES: 40% commission will be charged on all artwork sales made directly through RAA&M (or 15% on any artwork sold elsewhere by the artist that a client originally saw at the RAA&M).
- Please Note: Artwork that is not removed from the RAA&M after an exhibition will become the property
  of the Rockport Art Association & Museum after one year.
